MOVING TARGET Sep. 5 & 6 2009 4:00 p.m.

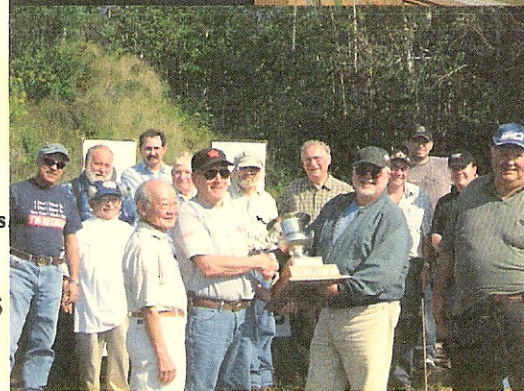
Five rounds are fired at each distances of (20, 15, 10 yds.) for a possible 180 points 3 tries for \$5.00

Any center fire pistol, revolver or shotgun can be used to knock down these 5 poppers set at varied distances. 3 tries for \$5.00

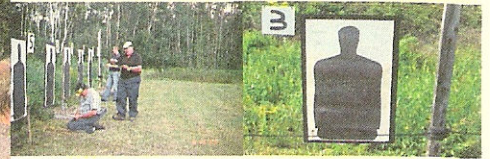

This match includes both the 600 and the 1500 scores which will be shot in one appearance at the line. In order to maximize range use we will be squading the P.P.C. into 2 relays per day at 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. each day. Must be certified P.P.C. shooters, some exceptions may apply at the Range Officer's discretion.

FIRE ALLEY Sep. 5 & 6 2009 All Day



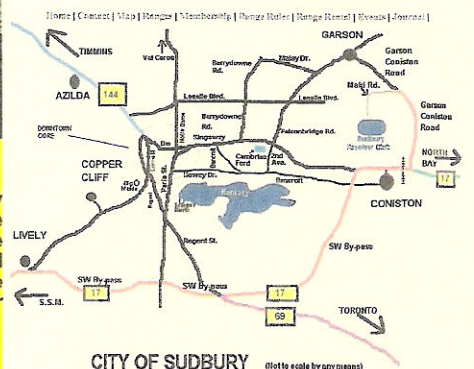
This match will be fired on the Rapid Fire Range. The course will consist of:

5 P.P.C. Targets (B-34)
5 rounds at 20 yds in 8 seconds
5 rounds at 15 yds in 6 seconds
5 rounds at 10 yds in 4 seconds

Each shooter will fire the course twice for a total of 30 rounds or 300 points. Both hands (Combat style) gun must rest in the ready position until the target starts to face. No holstered guns permitted. Any center fire revolver or self-loader. No I.S.S.F. guns. Target loads only no hard ball or jacketed ammo.
